This is Tachikawa

We've delved into the history of Tachikawa to rediscover its charms, including the origins of the place names and the circumstances surrounding its birth.

A In the Tachikawa area, there was Shibasaki Village, the predecessor of Tachikawa City, which formed spontaneously near the Tama River from the Old Stone Age and the Jomon Period, and Sunagawa Village, which was formed through the development of new rice fields in the Edo Period. The current Tachikawa City was formed in 1963 through the merger of Sunagawa Town (formerly Sunagawa Village) and Tachikawa City (formerly Shibasaki Village).

A In the former Shibasaki Village (south of the city area), there are the ruins of the Tachikawa family's mansion near the present-day Genbusan Fusajii Temple. The Tachikawa family was samurai who descended from the Himatsuri clan, which was part of the Nishi-tō, or Western Faction, of the Musashi Shichitō, a group of medieval warriors. It is thought that they settled in the Tachikawa area from around the end of the Heian period.

Were there any warriors or daimyo?

How was Tachikawa City formed?

The origin of Tachikawa's name remains uncertain. One theory suggests it came from the medieval samurai Tachikawa clan, who built their residence near Genbusan Fusajii Temple by the Tama River, calling it "Tatekawa" (meaning "residence river"). Another theory posits that the Tama River in this area was called "Tatenokawa" (meaning "vertical river") in contrast to the "Tamanoyokoyama" (Tama Hills) seen from the provincial capital during the Nara period.

What was Tachikawa like before?

Both Shibasaki and Sunagawa Villages were once simple farming villages. Though located along the Koshu Kaido and Itsukaichi Kaido roads, they were far from the bustling post towns of the time, presenting a stark contrast to today's Tachikawa.

Where does the name Tachikawa come from?

Pure white Tachikawa udo are grown in 3-meter-deep underground chambers called "muro," where sunlight is blocked. The temperature is kept at 18-20°C to promote growth.

The history of Tamagawa Josui, a natural space of water and greenery.

It all began in the era of Iemitsu, the third Tokugawa shogun. Due to the increase in population caused by the daimyo's alternating attendance at the Edo castle, Edo was suffering from a serious water shortage. As a solution, a waterway was planned that would supply water to the city of Edo. In 1654, the Tamagawa Waterworks, which is approximately 43km long, was completed by the brothers Shoemon and Kiyoemon, who later became famous as the Tamagawa Brothers. In 2003, it was designated as a national historic site.
